Thank you for having your septic system pumped at 12637 PULVER ROAD MH #1. Skagit County Public Health received your report (enclosed), which indicated deficiencies. Deficiencies that are not resolved can lead to additional repairs and/or system failure. This letter is to notify you of the deficiencies your provider discovered and encourage you to make the needed repairs.

The deficient component(s) are noted in **red** on your report, and your provider may have indicated additional details and recommendations for service or repairs in the "COMMENTS" section.

Given the flooded status of the system in late May, and the recommendation from your inspector to reach out to a designer, we strongly encourage that too. I have included a list of designers with his notice for you to reach out to and begin that process.

If your provider is scheduled to repair or resolve the deficiency, they will upload a "Follow Up" report noting the repairs that were made. This can be verified online at Skagit County Property One Stop.
