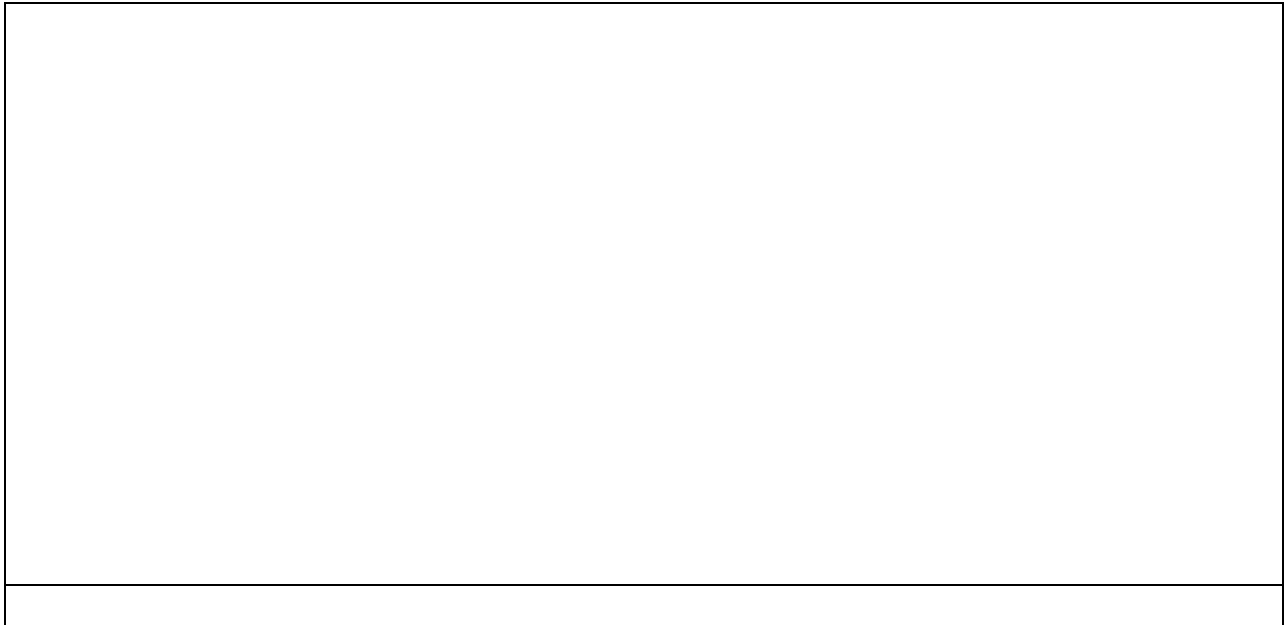

I figured out why it was hard to find. The boathouse was improperly valued on P66602. When I did the revaluation this year I talked to the owner of P66602 and looked at aerials to confirm the building wasn't on that parcel and moved the boathouse and permit to the parcel where the building actually is, which is P66601. I then credited the owner of P66602 with 3 years of tax credit for the value of the boathouse, which was \$800. Let me know if you have any other questions.
