

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, March 27, 2019** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining the following:

- a. **Shoreline Substantial Development Permit (PL18-0095) and Special Use Permit Modification (PL18-0186)** for Skagit County Parks and Recreation to restore fish habitat by reconnecting an approximately ½ mile long side channel to the Skagit River and improve park amenities. The project will include development of primitive camping sites, a group picnic shelter, and addition of interpretive elements along the trail system. The site is located at 59924 State Route 20 in Marblemount, WA. The project is located within the northeast quarter of Section 13, Township 35 North, Range 10 East, and within the northwest quarter of Section 18, Township 35 North, Range 11 East, W.M., Skagit County, WA.
