- A. Shoreline Substantial Development Permit #PL12-0150 by Skagit County Public Works to realign 1.39 miles of Francis Road by flattening horizontal curvature. The project aims to increase visibility and improve safety. Approximately 8 acres of additional right of way were obtained. Project activities include roadbed construction, new drainage ditches, paving, pavement markings and signs, the removal and reseeding of abandoned roadbed, and installation of a new stormwater treatment facility to treat new impervious surfaces. The project is located approximately 1 mile west of the intersection of Francis Road and State Route 9, near Clear Lake, adjacent to Debay's Slough, within a portion of Sections 2 and 3, Township 34 North, Range 4 East, W.M. in Skagit County, Washington. The pole will be located 13.5 ft at its closest point and 104+ ft. at its furthest point from the property lines. The proposed project is located within the Rural Village Residential (RVR) and the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted September 20, 2011 and as there after amended. The facility would include the creation of a impervious fire fighter/emergency personnel training area which can be also used for secondary an overflow

parking area for them and the public including Big Lake Elementary School.
