- A. Consider the Remand from the Board of Skagit County Commissioners concerning Appeal PL14-0117 and PL13-0354 by Tom Butler and Linda Lewis of Skagit County Planning & Development Services approval of Administrative Reduction in Setbacks and approval of Reasonable Use Exemption, both for Hazel Ford. - B. Tesoro Refining & Marketing Company LLC filed a shoreline substantial development permit application (PL14-0030) and a critical areas variance application (PL14-0031) to expand Tesoro Refinery's Gate 20 parking lot. The project includes expanding the parking area from 500 spaces to 1,350 spaces, 5.6 acres to 12.2 acres, to accommodate increased refinery personnel during peak work events. The project is located at 10200 West March Point Road, Anacortes, WA, within a portion of Section 28, Township 35 North, Range 2 East, Skagit County, WA Parcel 32993. Staff Contact: John Cooper
