The applicant has proposed to build a new deck 23.7 feet landward of the Ordinary High Water Mark (OHWM) and a new residence 29.7 feet landward of the OHWM. The proposed project is located at 34096 North Shore Drive, within a portion of Section 23, Township 33 North, Range 6 East, W.M., Skagit County.
