

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, February 9, 2011** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at the hour of **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining whether the Hearing Examiner should approve, uphold or deny the following:

**A. Special Use Permit application (#PL10-0482)** by the Upper Skagit Indian Tribe for the installation of a temporary wind assessment tower. The project proposal includes the installation of a 200 foot tall pole tower with wind assessment equipment (anemometer, vane, etc.) located on the pole. The tower foundation is a 10.5 square foot steel plate set on existing grade with 4 stabilizing guy wires anchored at 160 feet from the tower. The project is located within a designated Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted October 10, 2007, and as thereafter amended. Located on an undeveloped 17.55 acre parcel that is accessed from 4997 Hobson Road, Bow, located in the northeast ¼ of the northwest ¼ within a portion of Section 31, Township 36N, Range 4 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.
