

## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold a public hearing on **Wednesday, June 8, 2011** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at the hour of **9:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining whether the Hearing Examiner should approve, uphold or deny the following:

- A. **Special Use Permit Application #PL11-0069** submitted by Skagit County Public Utility District #1 for “Phase II” waterline improvements along Josh Wilson Road. The project proposal consists of the installation of approximately 20,031 lineal feet (LF) of restrained 18-inch ductile iron water transmission main, including but not limited to, a 6” pressure reducing station, telemetry provisions and miscellaneous appurtenances. The purpose of this project is to facilitate build-out of the Major Capital Improvements identified in the District’s State-approved 2007 Water System Plan. The project is located within the designated Rural Reserve (RRv), Agricultural Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL), Bayview Ridge Urban Reserve (BR-URv), and Bayview Ridge Light Industrial (BR-LI) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted October 10, 2007, and as thereafter amended. Located within the right-of-way associated with Josh Wilson Road. Beginning just westerly of the intersection of Josh Wilson Road and Chuckanut Drive and continuing westerly along the northern one-half of the road way to the point of terminus which is located at Higgins Airport Way, Burlington, within portions of Sections 30 & 31, Township 35N, Range 4 E W.M., and portions of Sections 25, 26, 27, 34, 35 and 36 Township 35N, Range 3 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.
