FINDINGS

- 1. Stewart Landefeld and Margaret Breen seek to include one acre in the Current Use Open Space Land program.
- 2. The property is located on the Padilla Bay side of Guemes Island. It comprises Lots A-1 and B-1, Short Plat #521-81, located in Sec. 26, T36N, R1E, W.M. The Assessor's Parcel numbers are P114329 and P114331.
- 3. The applicants describe the property and it use as follows: "This is somewhat contiguous to our other lots in that it abuts our partly owned road, but it sits mostly between a single family house owned by someone else, and the Guemes Island Resort, and is used by people walking across the lower portion of it by the beach."
- 4. The new classification would conserve natural and scenic resources, protect natural shorelines, protect wildlife and plant habitat, promote conservation, enhance recreational opportunities and promote visual quality.
- 5. The hearing was held after due notice. There was no public testimony and there were no written comments.
 - 6. The Examiner admitted the exhibits submitted by Staff.
 - 7. The Examiner finds that the property meets the definition of the classification sought.
 - 8. The Staff recommends approval. The Examiner concurs with Staff.
