FINDINGS

- 1. Robert and Ann Raish seek to transfer 39 acres from Current Use Farm and Agriculture to Current Use Open Space Farm and Agricultural Conservation.
- 2. The property's location is: NE1/4SW1/4 Sec. 27, T35N, R3E, W.M., except the following described tract of land: Beginning at the southwest corner of the NE1/4SW1/4, thence north 440 feet to the point of beginning; thence east 360 feet; thence north 120 feet; thence west 360 feet; thence south 120 feet to the point of beginning.
- 3. Improvements on the property include a house and two barns. The property was formerly used for a horse breeding business. Currently there are riding trails and pasture. The property does not now meet the requirement for gross commercial agricultural income.
- 4. The plan is to resume a horse related business starting in 2017 and to grow, harvest and sell hay. There is a high potential for the property to return to the Current Use Farm and Agriculture Program in the current decade.
- 5. The hearing was held after due notice. There was no public testimony and there were no written comments.
 - 6. The Examiner admitted the exhibits submitted by Staff.
 - 7. The Examiner finds that the property meets the definition of the classification sought.
 - 8. The Staff recommends approval. The Examiner concurs with Staff.

RECOMMENDATION

The Examiner recommends approval of the application.
