Board Discussion

Veterans Community Park

A website will be developed to better accommodate the funds that will be funneling to the non-profit account. Placards, picnic tables, flag poles, pavers, benches and other amenities will be available to clubs and individuals to sponsor. Ted Carney has proposed various length flagpoles dependent on the flag. The tallest pole will be 60' in height. Pavers and placards will cost in the \$120 range. There will be opportunities for other amenities, such as benches, tables, art, and artifacts. Individuals, service clubs, cities, and businesses will be involved. The webpage is being developed for the park's promotion. Its paramount to keep momentum after the shelter is completed.

Barney Lake Trail

Liz provided an update on the progress of the Centennial Trail. An RCO grant application has been submitted for developing a section of trail along Barney Lake.
