The BMX Group came to the meeting and pitched their proposal for a course at NSRA. The Board asked staff if they would be willing to do a site visit with the BMX group to discuss locations. Brian agreed to meet in the field in September, after Labor Day.

NSRA Follow-up to Field Visit—Bridge and Trail Discussion: The Board felt it was important to have public works replace the bridge. The Board mentioned the importance of the crossing, the fact it is a crucial component in the master plan, and that the structures PW placed in the creek may have led to the directional change of flow.

Centennial Trail: Snohomish County is almost done with the trail. The board discussed the potential for improvements to the Centennial; Trail near the southern boundary.

Parks & Recreation Comprehensive Plan

Most of the meeting was dedicated to discussing the survey results.

Projects summarized by Brian and discussed by the Board:

- -Donovan Park Improvements: shelter in future plans
- -Trail Projects—SW Trail discussed and supported. The Rotary Club has been pushing for ADA access between Polte and just east of Fruitdale Road. The trail can cross over to NSRA at Fruitdale. Sedro-Woolley has been making improvements over the years to the trail that runs along McGarigle. The community has asked for improvements to the trail running into the park.
- -HMSP Cabin: On schedule for September completion.
- -Cleveland Park: possible playground improvements and service club support.
