

THURSDAY MEN'S DIVISIONS – Week 1 Schedule (September 10th)

Following are game times for the TWO **Thursday MEN'S Divisions** that will begin play in the Skagit County Parks & Recreation – [2026 FALL SOFTBALL LEAGUE](#) on Thursday, September 10th at the Skagit Valley Playfields in Mount Vernon. Please inform your teammates of your game time(s) for next week.

- **Wednesday Games** – Note that the plan is to schedule each team 1-2 Wednesday night doubleheaders for the Fall League. We're not playing Wednesday, September 9th for week 1 since the Seahawks season opener is this night, as well.

On-Line Forms via Softball Page – You can get a Team Roster and Participant Waiver Forms on-line to fill out ahead of time, if you'd like. Each player will need to fill out the Team Roster and an individual Participant Waiver Form. These can either be turned in at the Playfields prior to your first game(s) or scanned and e-mailed back to me. NOTE that if your team is returning from the Spring League that you can re-use your roster from the spring. Also, players only need to fill out one Participant Waiver Form for spring-summer-fall.

- **Additional League Information:**
 - Game Balls – Teams will be provided game balls for when scheduled as the home team at the fields.
 - Team Packet – IF your team did not play in the Spring League, we'll provide a team packet for you with rosters, waivers, USA Softball Rule Book, scorebook, etc.
 - Scorebook (provided for any new teams, though we may have available for returning teams that need them)

 - **WEATHER NOTICE** – Our local weather can often remain quite good through October, though there's still a likelihood of wetter weather as we play into the end of October with the Fall League. Teams should be prepared to play in wetter than normal conditions with the likelihood of any rained out games not being made up. IF there are any rained out games in the season not made up, teams will be credited back for any games not played.

Games for Thursday, September 10th at the Skagit Valley Playfields in Mount Vernon:

- Please verify if your team is scheduled to play a doubleheader on 9/10. NOTE that this division will play 10 games in 6 weeks (September 10th through October 15th).
- RAIN OUT HOTLINE: 360-416-1361 x1.
- **REMINDER: 1-AND-1 Count for Batters** – In USA Softball all batters shall assume a one ball, one strike count upon entering the batters box.
- **PITCHER FACEMASKS** – Note that all pitchers will be required to wear a Facemask for all league play. IF a team does not have a Facemask this season, the Skagit Valley Softball Association (SVSA) will provide one to borrow during games.
