Proposal Description

The Growth Management Act provides that "each comprehensive land use plan and development regulations shall be subject to continuing review and evaluation" (RCW 36.70A.130(1)(a)) and requires Skagit County to periodically accept petitions for amendments or revisions to our Comprehensive Plan policies, land use map, and development regulations. Skagit County implements this requirement through Skagit County Code Chapter (SCC) 14.08, which describes the process for annual amendments.

On June 14, 2022, the Skagit Board of County Commissioners voted to approve the 2022 Docket of Proposed Policy, Code, and Map Amendments, which included two citizen-initiated proposals and five staff proposals. Skagit County Planning and Development Services is now proposing to add the following two staff proposals to the 2022 Docket:

- C22-4 Economic Development Plan Amendment: add a new goal to the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan Economic Development chapter to allow for funds expended under RCW Chapter 82.14 to finance all public facilities listed in the Comprehensive Plan (including subarea plans) for economic development purposes.
- C22-5 Seawater Intrusion Areas Amendment: change the requirement for a county hydrogeologist to review proposed new wells in a seawater intrusion area to allow for any licensed hydrogeologist to perform the review.

Public hearing testimony is usually limited to three minutes, so written comments are preferred.
