## 1 **14.38.030 Disclosure.**

- 2 (1) No change.
- 3 (2) The following shall constitute the disclosure required by this Section:
- 4 "This disclosure applies to parcels liesdesignated within an area or within 1 mile of an
- 5 area designated as agricultural land or within 1/4 mile of rural resource, forest or mineral
- 6 resource lands of long-term commercial significance in Skagit County. A variety of
- 7 Natural Resource Land commercial activities occur or may occur in the area that may not
- 8 be compatible with non-resource uses and may be inconvenient or cause discomfort to
- 9 area residents. This may arise from the use of chemicals; or from spraying, pruning,
- 10 harvesting or mineral extraction with associated activities, which occasionally generates
- 11 traffic, dust, smoke, noise, and odor. Skagit County has established natural resource
- 12 management operations as a priority use on designated Natural Resource Lands, and area
- 13 residents should be prepared to accept such incompatibilities, inconveniences or
- 14 discomfort from normal, necessary Natural Resource Land operations when performed in
- 15 compliance with Best Management Practices and local, State, and Federal law." In the
- 16 case of mineral lands, application might be made for mining-related activities including
- 17 extraction, washing, crushing, stockpiling, blasting, transporting and recycling of
- 18 minerals. If you are adjacent to designated NR Lands, you will have setback requirements
- 19 from designated NR Lands. (Ord. 17938 Attch. F (part), 2000)
