Notice is hereby given that on September 5, 2002, Skagit County approved PL02-0411, a Administrative Special Use permit application for the placement of a manufactured home on a parcel of property with an existing residence for the purpose of taking care of an elderly relative. The proposed project is located within a Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/Comprehensive Plan designated area as identified within the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps as adopted July 24, 2000.
