The applicant proposes to harvest the timber on the subject site including salvage of wind throw trees. The cleared area will be utilized to construct a barn and a single family residence on each parcel. The proposed forest practice is located on the parcels located immediately north of 15844 Yokeko Drive, Anacortes, WA; within a portion of the south east quarter of Section 24, Township 34 North, Range 1 East, Skagit County, WA (parcels *P115508 & 115507*).

Other permits that may be necessary in the development of the project but not included in the above noted application include a building permit and critical areas authorization.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was deemed complete, which was March 21, 2007 unless such time period is extended consistent with RCW 36.70B.090. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or be notified of the action taken on this application should notify John Cooper, Planner, in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is March 29, 2007. Written comments must be received by 4:30 p.m. April 16, 2007.

The Lead Agency expects to issue a DNS for this proposal and the Optional DNS is being used. This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal.
