The proposed project is located within the Agricultural Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL), Rural Intermediate (RI), and Rural Business (RB) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 24, 2000, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was issued and the application was determined to be complete on March 26, 2007.

The project is located along the northwest bank of the Skagit River between Bennett Road and Memorial Highway (SR 536) within a portion of Sections 12 & 13, Township 34N, Range 3 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.

A completed Grading permit, Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request.

No other governmental approvals or permits will be required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined compete, which was <u>3-26-07</u>. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
