Administrative Special Use Permit Modification application File #PL17-0339

Notice is hereby given that on July 31, 2017, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the Administrative Special Use Permit Modification request (#PL17-0339) submitted by of Public Utility District #1 of Skagit County (PUD #1) to modify a previously approved Administrative Special Use permit request (#PL16-0460) for the Higgins Airport Way Fiber Optic Project. This revised project consists of the additional installation of approximately 6,000 linear feet of conduit and new fiber optic cable along Steele Road, Knudson Road, and Water Tank Road for a revised total of approximately 9,300 linear feet of new fiber optic cable. The proposed project is located within the Bayview Ridge Light Industrial (BR-LI) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016. In addition to the previously approved project located along Higgins Airport Way from Josh Wilson Road, 3,300 linear feet south, to a short distance past Steele Road, the revised project will now include installing fiber optic cable along Steele Road, Knudson Road, and Water Tank Road, Burlington, within a portion of Section 34, Township 35N, Range 3E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision to the Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06. Standing to bring an appeal shall be limited to aggrieved parties. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Development Services Department within 14 calendar days of the date of the Decision.
