Notice is hereby given that on January 25, 2017, Scimitar Construction, on behalf of Jeanine Bronco, filed an Administrative Setback Reduction request (#PL17-0030) for the construction of a 2,880 (60' x 48') square foot shop building not able to meet the required 20 foot setback from the access and utility easement (secondary front property line) running partially through the property. The request is to reduce the required secondary front setback from 20 feet to an 8 foot setback. The subject property is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016. A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was <u>February 6, 2017</u>, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
