Notice is hereby given that on January 23, 2017 Skagit County approved Administrative Special Use Permit Application PL16-0390 submitted by James Easterlin on behalf of John Christianson to operate a marijuana production and processing facility within an existing 6,120 square foot barn/storage building.

The project is located at 15612 Best Road, Mount Vernon within a portion of Section 20, Township 45N, Range 03E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. P22201.

The application was deemed complete as of September 19, 2016. The Notice of Development was published and posted on the property on September 29, 2016.

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Administrative Official to the Skagit County Hearing Examiner pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.110(7). Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Development Services within 14 calendar days of the date of this decision pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.
