Notice is hereby given that on January 11, 2017 the Skagit County Hearing Examiner denied an Appeal filed under PL16-0348 and upheld the approval of Special Use permit application PL16-0007. The special use permit application was submitted Andy King /Meridian Group, on behalf of Parallel Infrastructure/Skagit 911 for a new Skagit 911 Wireless Communication Facility which will consist of a 195' tall steel lattice tower with four (4) omni antennas, one (1) 6-foot wide microwave dish antenna, equipment cabinets and 50KW back up diesel generator. The project is located within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps. The tower site is located on parcel P45149 at 7089 Powerline Road, Marblemount, WA within Section 12, Township 35 North, Range 10 East, W.M; Skagit County, WA.
