**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Notice is hereby given that on June 5, 2017, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist review #PL17-0193 for the removal of approximately 350 cubic yards of accumulated sediment from a 250 foot stretch of Fish Creek downstream of the Grassmere Road crossing. The proposed project is located within the Town of Concrete Urban Growth Area (UGA) within the Urban Reserve Commercial Industrial (URC-I) and within the Urban Reserve Residential (URR) zoning/comprehensive plan designated areas as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended.

**PROPONENT:** Skagit County Public Works, c/o Emily Derenne, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, WA 98273.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The project is located along Grassmere Road, south of 44479 Grassmere Road, Concrete, within a portion of Section 9, Township 35N, Range 8E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington.

**LEAD AGENCY:** Skagit County Planning and Development Services.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(C). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist, critical areas checklist, and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

**The Lead Agency previously issued a comment period for this proposal under the Optional DNS process outlined under WAC 197-11-355.**

You may appeal this threshold determination by addressing those criteria as set forth in Skagit County Code 14.06 and 16.12 and then by filing such with the Skagit County Planning and Development Services for service to the SEPA responsible official within fourteen (14) calendar days after the publication date of this threshold determination.
