A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was <u>April 25, 2017</u>, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal.
