Notice is hereby given that on September 20, 2017, Skagit County Fire Protection District #7/Lake Cavanaugh Volunteer Fire Department filed an Administrative Special Use permit application (#PL17-0512), an Administrative Setback Reduction permit application (#PL17-0513) and a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist for the construction of a 3-bay, 2400 square foot metal pole building to house emergency response vehicles. The proposed project is located within the Secondary Forest – Natural Resource Lands (SF-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The application was determined to be complete for review purposes on October 23, 2017.

The project is located on a 1.81 acre site at 33763 North Shore Drive, Mount Vernon within a portion of Section 22, Township 33N, Range 6E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P66482).

A completed Administrative Special Use permit application, Administrative Setback Reduction permit application, Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined complete, which was <u>10-23-17</u>. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project. Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Allison Sanders in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is <u>10-26-17</u>. Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal.
