PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Notice is hereby given that on September 18, 2017, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist #PL17-0466 for the removal of an existing 13' wide by 60' long wooden bridge and the construction/placement of a new 14' wide by 60' long concrete bridge serving 4 single family residences and a kennel business. The proposed project is located within the Rural Resource – Natural Resource Lands (RRc-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended.

PROPONENT: Karl Koehler, 25209 Starview Drive, Mount Vernon, WA 98273.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located on a 3.85 acre site to the east of Beaver Lake Road, on Starview Drive, near 25209 Starview Drive, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 16, Township 35N, Range 7E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P30471).

LEAD AGENCY: Skagit County Planning and Development Services.

The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(C). This decision was made after review of a completed environmental checklist, critical areas checklist, and other information on file with the lead agency. This information is available to the public on request.

You may appeal this threshold determination by addressing those criteria as set forth in Skagit County Code 14.06 and 16.12 and then by filing such with the Skagit County Planning and Development Services for service to the SEPA responsible official within fourteen (14) calendar days after the publication date of this threshold determination.

Appeals must be submitted by: **October 5, 2017.**
