Notice is hereby given that on April 23, 2018, John Johnston of Chuckanut Engineering, on behalf of Burlington-Edison School District, filed an independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist (#PL18-0217) for the Edison Elementary School Outdoor Track. The project proposal includes the construction of a ¹/₄ mile outdoor recreational track circling the existing outdoor playground area. The project is anticipated to require the excavation of approximately 81 cubic yards of material and the placement of approximately 551.53 cubic yards of material encompassing approximately 13,200 square feet. The proposed project is located within the Rural Village Residential zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete for review purposes on April 24, 2018.

The project is located at 5801 Main Ave, Bow, within a portion of Section 33, Township 36N, Range 3E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P48535, P48538, P106869)

Other governmental approvals or permits that will be required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services include: Approved Grading permit and Floodplain Development permit.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined compete, which was 4-24-18. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
