

SKAGIT COUNTY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION

Notice is hereby given that on February 1, 2018, Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife filed a Shoreline Substantial Development Permit for renovations at the Samish Hatchery Adult Fish Collection Facility. The project includes the demolition and construction of a new fish ladder and weir as well as modification of the existing hatchery intake structure including new intake screens designed with self-cleaning features. The proposal also includes habitat improvements such as placement of river flow scour protectors, large woody debris placements, invasive plant removal, native plant installation, and off channel rearing habitat improvements.

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcels P35897, P35792, P35851, and P35879. The site address is 6595 North Green Road.

The full application for this proposal is on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services (PDS), and will be reviewed under the provisions of Skagit County Code (SCC). This information is available to the public on request. Other permits that may be necessary in the development of the project but are not included in this application include: building permit, floodplain development permit.

A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is required for this project.

Any person desiring to comment on or to be notified of the decision on this application should notify PDS in writing within thirty days of the date of final publication of this notice, which is March 1, 2018. Skagit County accepts comments online only through the form at www.skagitcounty.net/pdscomments. To ensure comments are received and processed properly, comments are not accepted via email.

Written comments must be received by 4:30 pm, March 30, 2018.
