

# SKAGIT COUNTY PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT

## Administrative Setback Reduction Request File # PL18-0043

Notice is hereby given that on February 1, 2018, Ken Olsen of Olsen Associates, on behalf of Robert and Kaye Herman, filed an Administrative Setback Reduction request (#PL18-0043) to convert an existing deck to an enclosed living space and to add a 75 square foot tool shed adjacent to the enclosed space. Both the enclosed living space and proposed tool shed are not able to meet the required five foot side setback. The request is to reduce the required side setback from five feet to two feet. The subject property is located within the Bayview Ridge Residential (BR-R) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The application was determined to be complete for review purposes on February 22, 2018.

The project is located at 12601 Eagle Drive, Burlington, within a portion of Section 2, Township 34N, Range 3E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P79756).

A completed Administrative Setback Reduction request, Critical Areas Checklist, site plan and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. Other governmental approvals or permits that will be needed for this proposal from Planning and Development Services include: Approved Building Permit.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was February 22, 2018, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Allison Sanders in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 3-1-18. Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal. The file can be viewed at Planning and Development Services which is located at the Continental Place address listed below
