Notice is hereby given that on November 7, 2018, Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) filed a Shoreline Variance/Substantial Development/Conditional Use Permit PL18-0544. WSDOT proposes to construct a long-term bank stabilization project that will protect highway infrastructure, reduce maintenance, and reduce future impacts to protected aquatic species by supplementing and fortifying a series of rock groins installed in 2007, with gravity anchored cribwall and log-toe revetment along 480 feet of the Sauk River.

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcels P18704 and P107337 as well as the right-of-way for State Route 530.

The full application for this proposal is on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services (PDS), and will be reviewed under the provisions of Skagit County Code (SCC). This information is available to the public on request. Other permits that may be necessary in the development of the project but are not included in this application include: floodplain development.

A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is required for this project.
