The addition is not able to meet the required front setback. The request is to reduce the required front setback from 35 feet to 15 feet. The subject property is located within the Rural Intermediate (RI) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete for review purposes on September 17, 2018.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was September 17, 2018, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
