Notice is hereby given that on December 23, 2019, the Administrative Official approved an administrative critical area variance, PL19-0474 submitted by Brian & Hallie Holler to reduce the standard 110 foot Category III wetland buffer to 55 feet, reduction of the standard 150 foot riparian buffer from Butler Creek (bankfull width greater than 5 feet wide) to 75 feet and reduction of the standard 100 foot riparian buffer from an unnamed Type F Stream (bankfull width less than 5 feet wide) to 50 feet to accommodate the construction of an approximate 40' x 40' residence, 24' x 30' detached garage and septic system.

The project is located at 2648 Butler Creek Road, within the southeast <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 17, Township 36N, Range 04E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. P99015
