Notice is hereby given that on July 17, 2019, Mr. Robert Atterberry submitted an application for a forest practice conversion to harvest approximately 145,000 board feet of timber on a 6.7 acre parcel. The applicant proposes to prepare the site for subdivision and related residential development. After harvesting the timber, the applicant will remove stumps and complete some minor grading to fill the stump holes and level the area. The parcel is located within the Rural Intermediate zoning/comprehensive plan designated area. Other required permits and/or authorizations not included in the application may include: Skagit County subdivision approval, Skagit County building permits & Skagit County fire permits.

The subject site is located at 13841 Eagle Crest Lane, Skagit County, within a portion of Section 11, Township 34 North, Range 1 East, Skagit County, WA (Parcels *P19171*).

The application materials, SEPA check list, site plan and all pertinent information are on file at Skagit County Planning & Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the letter of completeness was issued, which was July 23, 2019, unless such time period is extended pursuant to SCC 14.06.210(3). A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project pursuant to SCC 14.06.110.

Any person desiring to express his or her views or be notified of the action taken on this application should notify John Cooper, Planner, in writing of his or her interest within fifteen (15) days following the date of publication of this notice which is July 25, 2019. Any person has the right to comment on the application, receive notice, participate in any hearings, request a copy of the decision (once made), and the right to appeal the decision. Failure to submit comments, or requests, during the comment period or at the public hearing could result in a loss of right to appeal.
