Notice is hereby given that on March 4, 2019, Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife, filed a Shoreline Substantial Development/Variance/Conditional Use Permit application PL19-0101 and a Critical Areas Variance application PL19-0096 to remove the failed boat ramp planks, replace it with a new boat ramp with articulated concrete mats on all sides, add a boarding float with a new concrete abutment adjacent to the new ramp, replace the existing vault toilet with a new double ADA compliant vault toilet, resurface the existing asphalt road and parking area, add a new asphalt parking area, relocate existing barrier rock, add a new covered picnic shelter, remove some existing paving and replace that area with a grass filter strip.

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcel P19274. The site is located at 5834 Campbell Lake Road in Anacortes, WA.
