Notice is hereby given that on February 19, 2019, Art Petersen - Architect, on behalf of Lawrence Hahn, filed a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist in conjunction with Grading Permit application #BP19-0118 for the placement of approximately 510 cubic yards of material and the excavation of approximately 1,175 cubic yards of material for the construction of an access roadway on a 1.38 acre site. The roadway will serve a three (3) lot land division proposed under Binding Site Plan #PL18-0573 and a proposed new building of approximately 6,480 square feet. The proposed project is located within the Anacortes UGA Urban Development District (A-UD) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The City of Anacortes classifies the site as Light Manufacturing - 1 (LM-1). A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete for review purposes on March 19, 2019.

The project is located at 9723 Padilla Heights Road, Anacortes, within a portion of Section 3, Township 34N, Range 2E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P131234)

A completed Grading permit, Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. No other governmental approvals or permits will be required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined compete, which was 3-19-19. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project. Any person desiring to express his or her views or to be notified of the action taken on this application should notify Brandon Black in writing of his or her interest within Fifteen (15) days of the date of publication of this notice which is 3-21-19. Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal.
