PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Notice is hereby given that on March 18, 2019, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist review completed in conjunction with Special Use Permit #PL19-0057 proposed by Peter Carletti of Carletti Architects, on behalf of Skagit County Fire District #2. The project proposal is to remove approximately 1,860 square foot of the existing fire station footprint containing the training room and some office areas, including the basement and second floor, to allow for the construction of a new 3,674 square foot first floor training room and office area, along with a small second floor area for offices of 860 square feet, for a total of 4,534 new square feet. The project is located within the Agricultural-Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016, and as thereafter amended.
