NOTICE OF DECISION

Shoreline Substantial Development and Variance Application PL18-0045 for Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife (WDFW)

On February 11, 2019, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved, with conditions, a shoreline substantial development and variance application for the improvements to the Samish River Fish Hatchery. The improvements include replacing the hatchery intake, fish ladder, and weir, as well as construction of a small mechanical building.

On March 20, 2019, the Department of Ecology issued its decision on the shoreline permit application. Additional conditions are included in the Ecology decision. A copy of that decision can be obtained from the Skagit County Department of Planning and Development Services. A DNS was issued by WDFW on October 4, 2017.

This decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board within 21 days of the date of the Ecology decision. Appeals must be filed in accordance with the provisions of WAC 461-08.
