The proposed facility is not able to meet the required thirty five foot rear setback (West property line) and the thirty five foot front setback (East property line). The request is to reduce the required rear setback from thirty-five to three feet and the required front setback from thirty five to thirty two feet. The subject property is located within the Agricultural-Natural Resource Lands (AG-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The application was determined to be complete for review purposes on April 30, 2019.

The project is located at 15452 Beaver Marsh Road, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 22, Township 34N, Range 3E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P22282).

A completed Administrative Setback Reduction request, Critical Areas Checklist, site plan and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. Other governmental approvals or permits that will be needed for this proposal from Planning and Development Services include: Approved Building Permit.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined to be complete, which was April 30, 2019, pursuant to SCC 14.06.210. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
