Notice is hereby given that on March 1, 2019, James and Dixie Nash filed a critical areas variance application to reduce the standard 300 foot wetland buffer and 100 foot lake shoreline buffer to a minimum of 35 feet to accommodate construction of a replacement residence on Lake 16. On April 26, 2019 a Shoreline Variance/Substantial Development/Conditional Use application was filed to reduce the average 53 foot setback from Lake 16 to 35 feet for the replacement residence.

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcel number P66180. The site is located at 20925 Lake Sixteen Road within a portion of the SW ¼ of Section 15, Township 33 N, Range 4 E, W.M., Skagit County, WA.

The full application for this proposal is on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services (PDS), and will be reviewed under the provisions of Skagit County Code (SCC).
