**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** Notice is hereby given that on April 23, 2019, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist review (#PL19-0104) for the construction of a 30,000 square foot (60' x 500') chicken barn on 16.48 acres to replace one that burnt down. The project is located within the Agricultural Natural Resource Lands zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016, and as thereafter amended.

**PROJECT LOCATION:** The project is located at 14251 River Bend Road, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 12, Township 34 N, Range 3 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P21534)

**LEAD AGENCY:** Skagit County Planning and Development Services.
