Notice is hereby given that the Skagit County Hearing Examiner will hold an open record appeal public hearing on **Wednesday, October 23, 2019** in the Board of County Commissioners Hearing Room, 1800 Continental Place, Mount Vernon, Washington, at **10:00 a.m.** or soon thereafter, for the purpose of determining the following:

Appeal PL18-0200 filed by Miles Sand and Gravel Company and Concrete Northwest on April 16, 2018 requesting reversal of an April 5, 2018 administrative decision of Skagit County Planning and Development Services to deny **Special Use Permit application PL16-0097** for failure to timely submit requested information pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.105.

The special use permit application is for the development of a proposed 68-acre sand and gravel mine located northwest of Sedro-Woolley, with access onto Grip Road, approximately 0.7 miles east of the intersection of Grip Road to Prairie Road, within Section 27, Township 36 North, Range 4 East, W.M., Skagit County.
