Administrative Special Use Permit request File #PL19-0383

Notice is hereby given that on October 7, 2019, Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the Administrative Special Use Permit request (#PL19-0383) submitted by Wendy LaRocque on behalf of Skagit PUD for a minor utility development to construct an automated bulk water loading station (fill station) to provide self-serve water to the public. The proposed project is located in the Minkler Road Right of Way (RoW) within the Rural Reserve (RRv) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area and adjacent to the Agricultural – Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The project is located adjacent to 24972 Minkler Road, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 19, Township 35N, Range 5E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (adjacent to P39774).

Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Development Services Department within 14 calendar days of the date of the Decision.
