

## **NOTICE OF DECISION**

### **Shoreline Substantial Development Permit Application PL19-0101 Critical Areas Variance Application PL19-0096 for WDFW**

On August 20, 2019, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved, with conditions, a shoreline substantial development permit and critical areas variance for the replacement of a failed boat ramp, construction of a boarding float, construction of a picnic shelter, replacement of a vault toilet, and grading and resurfacing of the existing driveway and parking area.

On September 25, 2019, the Department of Ecology issued notice of receipt for the shoreline substantial development permit application. A copy of that letter can be obtained from the Skagit County Department of Planning and Development Services.

This decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board within 21 days of the date of the Ecology date of filing, September 23, 2019. Appeals must be filed in accordance with the provisions of WAC 461-08.

The proposed project is located at 5834 Campbell Lake Road, Anacortes, Washington, with the SE ¼ of Section 12, Township 34 North, Range 1 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. P19274.
