Notice is hereby given that on September 17, 2019; the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved Special Use Permit application PL19-0128 for the modification of the Master Plan for Camp Korey (formally known as Camp Brotherhood) that was originally approved under SPU92-046. The modification proposes a smaller expansion to the camp than approved in the original master plan and will include upgrades to existing buildings and infrastructure and the addition of approximately 50,000 square feet of cabins, recreation, administrative and support buildings, additional roads/parking areas in a 10 year phased development plan.

The project is located at 24880 Brotherhood Road, within a portion of Section 30, Township 33N, Range 05 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (P18288, P18292, P18315, P18359, P18365, P18366, P18369, P18370, & P119623)

Pursuant to Skagit County Code 14.06.200, the Notice of Decision shall be forwarded to parties of record, the applicant and other applicable parties of interest.

The applicant and/or a party of record may appeal the decision of the Hearing Examiner to the Skagit County Board of Commissioners pursuant to the provisions of Section 14.06.110. Parties with standing to appeal must submit the appeal form and appeal fees to the Planning and Development Services Department within 14 calendar days of the date of the Decision.
