

NOTICE OF DECISION

Shoreline Substantial Development/Variance Application PL20-0190 for Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission

On October 23, 2020, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved, with conditions, a shoreline substantial development/variance application for the construction of a pedestrian overpass bridge above railroad tracks, create a new recreation trail, and install an ADA accessible vault toilet within Larrabee State Park. The new overpass bridge will provide safe pedestrian access to Clayton Beach.

On December 21, 2020, the Department of Ecology issued its decision on the shoreline variance application. Additional conditions are included in the Ecology decision. A copy of that decision can be obtained from the Skagit County Department of Planning and Development Services.

This decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board within 21 days of the date of the Ecology decision. Appeals must be filed in accordance with the provisions of WAC 461-08.

Applicant: Washington State Parks and Recreation Commission

The proposed project is located at Larrabee State Park near Clayton Beach on the shoreline of Samish Bay within the NW ¼ of Section 6, Township 36 North, Range 3 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. P47653 & P47654.
