The request is to reduce the standard thirty five foot front setback to twenty feet. The subject property line). The application was determined to be complete for review purposes on December 13, 2019.

The project is located at 17239 Lake View Boulevard, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 36, Township 34N, Range 4E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P64406).
