NOTICE OF DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION**

Notice is hereby given that on December 12, 2019, Chris Gourley, on behalf of the Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife, filed an administrative special use permit application to renovate the existing park facilities at the Campbell Lake boat launch. The project includes replacement of the failed boat launch ramp, construction of a boarding float, construction of a picnic shelter, replacement of a vault toilet, and grading and resurfacing of the existing driveway and parking area. The site has been classified as a specialized recreation area (SCC 14.04.020) and must be authorized by a special use permit (SCC 14.16.900(1)(b)).

The proposed project is located within a portion of the property described as parcel number P19274. The site is located at 5834 Campbell Lake Road in Anacortes, WA.

The full application for this proposal is on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services (PDS), and will be reviewed under the provisions of Skagit County Code (SCC). This information is available to the public on request. Other permits that may be necessary in the development of the project but are not included in this application include: grading permit, floodplain development permit, building permit, shoreline permit, and critical areas variance.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application is determined to be complete pursuant to SCC 14.06.210.

Any person desiring to comment on or to be notified of the decision on this application should notify PDS in writing within fifteen days of the date of publication of this notice. Failure to respond within the comment period could result in loss of the right to appeal. Skagit County accepts comments online only through the form at www.skagitcounty.net/pdscomments. To ensure comments are received and processed properly, comments are not accepted via email.

Written comments must be received by 4:30 pm, January 24, 2020.
