Notice is hereby given that on January 6, 2021, Emmett Wild with Skagit Conservation District, on behalf of Hillview Dairy, c/o Peter and Dale Wolters, filed an independent State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist (#PL20-0545) for the construction of a 3,200 (40' x 80') square foot pole building for manure storage. The completed project will result in 72,259 cumulative square feet of structures on the approximate 160 acre farm site/property. The project is located within the Agricultural Natural Resource Lands zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016, and as thereafter amended. A letter of completeness was not issued and the application was determined to be complete on January 11, 2021.

The project is located at 10814 N. Gardner Road, immediately south of and adjacent to 19497 Gear Road, Burlington, within a portion of Section 29, Township 35 N, Range 4 E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington. (Project location = P38074) additional acreage includes P38058, P38061, P38068, P38072, P38073.

An Environmental Checklist, site plan, and other application materials are on file with Skagit County Planning and Development Services. This information is available to the public on request. Other governmental approvals or permits required for this proposal from Skagit County Planning and Development Services include: Approved Building and Floodplain Permits.

A decision on the application will be made within 120 days of the date the application was determined compete, which was <u>1-11-21</u>. A public hearing before the Skagit County Hearing Examiner is not required for this project.
