Notice is hereby given that on February 24, 2021 Skagit County Planning and Development Services approved the Administrative Special Use Permit (#PL19-0499) submitted by Amy Wilhonen-Solvey for a one chair hair studio located in a small detached accessory structure which is considered a Home Based Business 2 per SCC 14.16.730. The proposed project is located within the Agricultural – Natural Resource Lands (Ag-NRL) zoning/comprehensive plan designated area as indicated in the Skagit County Comprehensive Plan and associated maps adopted July 5, 2016 and as thereafter amended. The project is located at 16799 Calhoun Rd, Mount Vernon, within a portion of Section 26, Township 34N, Range 3E W.M., situated within Skagit County, Washington (P22752).
