

NOTICE OF DECISION

Shoreline Substantial Development Permit Application PL20-0131 for Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife

On May 19, 2021, the Skagit County Hearing Examiner approved, with conditions, a shoreline substantial development permit application for to replace the boat launch and ramp approach at the Skagit Wildlife Area Headquarters Unit. A new ADA accessible loading platform and vehicle turnaround area will be added to the adjacent parking area.

On May 25, 2021, the Department of Ecology issued its decision on the shoreline permit application. A copy of that decision can be obtained from the Skagit County Department of Planning and Development Services.

This decision may be appealed to the Shoreline Hearings Board within 21 days of the date of the Ecology decision. Appeals must be filed in accordance with the provisions of WAC 461-08.

The proposed project is located at 21961 Wylie Road, Mount Vernon, Washington, within the NW ¼ of Section 25, Township 33 North, Range 3 East, W.M., Skagit County, Washington. P16106 & P16113.
